ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. <u>03</u> Series of 2017

SUBJECT

: GUIDELINES ON THE SELECTION/HIRING/COMPENSATION AND RELATED CONCERNS FOR PERSONNEL HIRED UNDER CONTRACTS OF SERVICE

In order to institutionalize a system for the selection, hiring and compensation of personnel under contracts of service, the Department hereby issues the guidelines for the processing thereof.

I. Coverage

This guidelines shall cover the DA Central Office, Bureaus, Regional Field Offices, Attached Agencies and other subordinate offices under the Department.

II. Definition/Features

- 1. The contract covers services where no employer-employee relationship exists. The personnel involved in the contract of service do not enjoy the benefits enjoyed by permanent employees.
- 2. The contract of service is not covered by Civil Service Law, Rules and Regulations, but is governed by the stipulations in their contract of service, and subject to government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 3. The contract of service shall not exceed six (6) months.

III. Guidelines in the Selection/Hiring

- 1. There is a need to augment the existing work force;
- 2. The personnel to be hired shall possess the necessary qualifications, such as but not limited to education, skills, and/or expertise, required for the particular job; and
- 3. The compensation shall be commensurate to the position and job description of his/her work assignment

IV. Documents Required in the Request for Authority to Hire

The following documents shall form part of the requirements and must be attached to the Request for Authority to Hire:

- A copy of approved PPMP reflecting the funds intended for the purpose;
- List of filled/unfilled plantilla positions;
- Justification on the need for additional personnel; and
- List of positions of Contract of Service personnel to be hired, its corresponding salary rates, actual duties and responsibilities, and Qualification Standards (QS) for the position being requested (see attached prescribed template, Annex 1).

V. Review Committee

The Review Committee under Special Order No. 1183 shall evaluate all requests for the hiring of Contract of Service personnel and conduct the screening process of applicants.

VI. Compensation

Contract of Service personnel shall be paid compensation not exceeding the minimum salary of an equivalent position and salary grade in the Position Classification and Compensation System (see attached compensation matrix, Annex 2).

VII. Approving Authority

The authority to hire Contract of Service Personnel in all DA Offices, including Bureaus, Regional Field Offices, Attached Agencies shall be approved by the DA Secretary.

VIII. Delegation of Authority

The authority to approve Contracts of Service for DA-Central Office shall be delegated to the Undersecretary for Administration while the authority to approve Contracts of Service for Bureaus, Regional Field Offices and Attached Agencies is hereby delegated to the concerned Heads of Agencies.

IX. Repealing Clause

This Administrative Order repeals, revokes and renders no force and effect any order or other issuances in conflict hereof.

X. Effectivity

This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately.
