MEMORANDUM ORDER

No. <u>45</u> Series of 2017

SUBJECT:

LIFTING THE TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM Jihomoravsky, Stredocesky and Jihocesky, Czech Republic

WHEREAS, based on the final report submitted by Dr Zbyněk Semerád, Director General, State Veterinary Administration, Veterinary Administration, Prague, Czech Republic to the World Organisation for Animal Health, that the Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) events in Czech Republic (with temporary banning order: DA MO No. 5, series of 2017) are now closed and resolved;

WHEREAS, in accordance to the provisions of Chapter 10.4, article 10.4.3 of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code 2016, Jihomoravsky, Stredocesky and Jihocesky in Czech Republic are now free from HPAI;

WHEREAS, based on the evaluation of the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), the risk of contamination from importing poultry and poultry products from Jihomoravsky, Stredocesky and Jihocesky in Czech Republic is negligible;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EMMANUEL F. PIÑOL, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby lift the temporary ban on the importation of domestic and wild birds¹ including poultry meat, day old chicks, eggs and semen originating from Jihomoravsky, Stredocesky and Jihocesky in Czech Republic.

All import transaction of the above products shall be in accordance with existing rules and regulations of the Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Animal Industry and National Meat Inspection Service (DA-BAI-NMIS).

All orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this order, are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

This ORDER shall take effect immediately.
