SUBJECT : SUSPENSION OF OFFICE WORK

DATE : November 11, 2020

The state weather bureau Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) has released the latest updates regarding Severe Tropical Storm "ULYSSES" which was estimated at 195 km Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes (14.6°N, 125.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 100 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 125 km/h. It is moving West Northwestward at 15 km/h. Tail-end of a cold front affecting Extreme Northern Luzon.

The forecast, weather conditions caused by Severe Tropical Storm "ULYSSES" is rains with gusty winds which is now raised to Signal No. 3. The impacts are Possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains. Possible light to moderate damage to structures and vegetation due to moderate to strong winds in Metro Manila, rest of Central Luzon, rest of CALABARZON, Mindoro Provinces, Romblon, Samar Provinces, Isabela, Quirino, and Nueva Vizcaya


Further, Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office has issued **RED ALERT** status in its memorandum dated November 11, 2020 following the Severe Weather Bulletin #13 of PAGASA for Severe Tropical Storm "Ulysses".

In view of the above, office work is hereby suspended on **November 11, 2020** (Wednesday) at 1:00 PM and **November 12, 2020** (Thursday) to give ample time to prepare and ensure safety of DA officials and employees as well as their respective families.

All are advised to time out thru biometric machine at 1:00 PM today.

You are all advised to take precautionary measures and safeguard your families for possible flashfloods and landslides severe tropical storm "ULYSSES" may bring.

PAGASA has issued tropical cyclone wind signal Number 3 over Metro Manila as of November 11, 2020, 1100H.
