3-Minute Speech Contest Mechanics

Qualifications

Any male or female young farmer or agri-enthusiast aged 18 to 30 years old

Guidelines

1. Each contestant shall only be given 2 minutes and 30 seconds to compose his/her ideas before the delivery. Use of paper and pen for this purpose is **NOT ALLOWED**.
The contestant shall use two cameras (front and rear) to ensure that there will be no cheating.
The microphone shall be always turned on except when the contestant's time is up.
The contestant shall deliver his/her piece while standing.
2. Each speech must be delivered for a minimum of two minutes to a maximum of three minutes.
3. The medium shall be in Filipino or English or Taglish. One topic shall be given to all contestants.
4. There shall be a specific link for the plenary/breakout room for the judges. The contestant shall be admitted to the aforementioned link once his/her name is called. All other waiting contestants shall be in an 'isolation room' which shall be a separate breakout room.
5. The plenary/breakout room for the judges and the contestants shall be recorded. Such recording shall be presented to the official link of the National Summit after the contest proper.
6. Three consecutive bell rings shall serve as a warning for the last minute of delivery. The microphone shall be automatically muted when his/her time is up.
7. The contest shall have a regional selection from March 1 to 31, 2022 and the deadline of submission of the finalists from the Region is on April 8, 2022.
8. All the finalists shall be judged on April 19, 2022 by the selected panel of judges, through an online platform.
9. Proper dress code (formal attire) must be observed.
10. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
11. Prizes are as follows:
 - 1st Prize: PhP 7,000 + plaque
 - 2nd Prize: PhP 5,000 + plaque
 - 3rd Prize: PhP 3,000 + plaque

Criteria for Judging

	Weight
<u>Organization of Ideas</u>	25%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Flow of ideas must be clear and appropriate to the topic• Speaker must focus to the key ideas and main points of the given topic	
<u>Content</u>	40%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sufficient use of logic, facts, examples, and/or expert opinion• Speaker must use information pertinent to the specific topic	
<u>Delivery</u>	35%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Appropriate use of pauses, punctuation, intonation, modulation of voice• Delivery must be natural and spontaneous• Speaker must exhibit poise and confidence
