SUBJECT: REASSIGNMENT OF PEDRO S. DUMARAOS JR. Ph.D. TO THE OFFICE OF THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR REGULATIONS

In the interest of service, **PEDRO S. DUMARAOS, JR. Ph.D.** of the Philippine Council for Agriculture and Fisheries is hereby reassigned to the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Regulations, Department of Agriculture, Diliman, Quezon City.



He shall perform the duties and responsibilities as DA Lead Coordinator for the continuing advocacy, information awareness on Food Safety, implementation of Food Safety Act of 2013, such as, but not limited to:

1. Convene the DA Food Safety Focal National and Regional Groups, for meetings, projects, trainings and other pertinent undertakings;
2. Organize the conduct of Food Safety Caravans, Food Safety Awareness Week, and other related advocacy campaigns;
3. Conduct periodic reviews/assessment of Food Safety plans as submitted by various Food Safety Regulatory Agencies (FSRAs) and Food Safety Support Agencies (FSSAs);
4. Coordinate with FSRAs, FSSAs, DA Regional Field Offices (DARFOs), other DA support units in the planning, implementation, consultation and harmonization of food safety initiatives in the DA;
5. Perform such other functions as may be required by the Assistant Secretary.

All expenses that may be incurred in the performance of his duties and responsibilities such as travelling expenses and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the fund of the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Regulations and other available funds, subject to existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders and memoranda inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
