SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO SPECIAL ORDER NO. 169 SERIES OF 2022 TITLED "CREATION OF THE AGENCY SCREENING COMMITTEE (ASC) FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE - FOOD DEVELOPMENT CENTER PURSUANT TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 14 s. of 2021 FOR CERTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY UNDER REPUBLIC ACT (R.A.) NO. 8439 AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11312"

The DA-FDC Agency Screening Committee shall ensure that the work done by DA-FDC qualified Science & Technology (S&T) personnel are contributing to the goals of the Department of Agriculture, i.e., for the direct benefit of the Filipino farmers/fisher folks through improvement of productivity, increase in income, and enhance competitiveness. The Magna Carta for S&T shall serve as incentive for productive and relevant S&T Activities (STA) in the DA. Further, the DA-FDC ASC shall be expected to faithfully adhere in the processing procedures set in the guidelines under Administrative Order No. 14, s.



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of 2021 and assist the agency head in evaluating each applicant's qualification for certification of eligibility.

The DA-FDC ASC shall perform the following functions:

1. Set the criteria for evaluation of applications in Agency Screening Committee;
2. Evaluate and validate the documents submitted by the FDC S&T personnel;
3. Submit to the DA Screening Committee its findings and recommendation for approval, and
4. Perform such other related functions as may be necessary to achieve the purpose for which the DA-FDC ASC was created.

All expenses to be incurred in relation to the performance of the DA-FDC ASC shall be chargeable against the DA-FDC funds, subject to the availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
