**SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT THE POST-EVALUATION AND  
FOR THE FARM AND FISHERIES CLUSTERING AND CONSOLIDATION  
(F2C2) PROGRAM ISLAND-WIDE CLUSTER SUMMITS**

In the interest of service, the Farm and Fisheries Clustering and Consolidation Program is hereby authorized to conduct the **F2C2 Program Island-Wide Cluster Summits Post-Evaluation** on **24-28 October 2022** in Region IVB.

The activity aims to:
