SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT TRAINING ON INTEGRATED ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL SAFEGUARDS MAINSTREAMING: ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL ASSESSMENT FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IN NCR, OUTSIDE GOVERNMENT FACILITIES

In the exigency of service, the Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP) is hereby authorized to conduct Training on Integrated Environmental and Social Safeguards Mainstreaming: Environmental and Social Assessment for Implementation of Infrastructure Projects on November 7-9, 2022 in NCR.

The training aims to gain knowledge on the PRDP Safeguards Framework, its basis, and key concepts; the importance of Social and Environmental Safeguards; and to apply the learnings in the preparation, evaluation, and implementation of agricultural infrastructure and enterprise, through training. At the end of the activity, a post-activity report will be prepared to include an assessment of the topics discussed which will serve as a benchmark on the next series of training on mainstreaming.
