**SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT THE PROVINCE-LED AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES EXTENSION SYSTEMS (PAFES) FY 2022 YEAR-END ASSESSMENT**

In the exigency of service, the Field Programs Coordination and Monitoring Division (FPCMD) is hereby authorized to conduct the Province-led Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Systems (PAFES) Year-end Physical and Financial Assessment on November 22 to 25, 2022 in Ilocos Norte, Region I.

The activity aims to:

- Assess the physical and financial Year-end accomplishment of PAFES implementation in the pilot and non-pilot provinces in the regions as well as the utilization of Php 89.9 million National Rice Program Funds in support to PAFES.
- Discuss problems encountered of each Operating Units (OU) during the program implementation.
