**SUBJECT: REVOCATION OF SPECIAL ORDER NO. 866, SERIES OF 2022**

---

Section 5 of Executive Order (E.O.) No. 113 dated December 24, 1986, entitled: *“Establishing the Comprehensive Agricultural Loan Fund (CALF), Creating the Agricultural Credit Policy Council (ACPC) and For Other Purposes”* created the Agricultural Credit Policy Council. Section 6 thereof further provides that “(a)n Executive Director shall be appointed by the Council.”

Being appointed by the Council, the ACPC Executive Director position falls beyond the coverage of the Career Executive Service and is a second-level executive/managerial position.<sup>i</sup> Once the requirements for the said position, including the appropriate eligibility prescribed by law, rules, and standards are met, the issued appointment is permanent in nature under E.O. No. 292, series of 1987, and the 2017 Omnibus Rules on Appointments and Other Human Resource Actions.<sup>ii</sup>

In view of the above and the provisions of Section 6 of E.O. No. 113, vesting the power of appointment of the ACPC Executive Director to the Council, Special Order No. 866, Series of 2022, with the subject: “DESIGNATION OF JOCELYN ALMA R. BADIOLA OFFICER-IN-CHARGE-EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, AGRICULTURAL CREDIT POLICY COUNCIL (OIC-EXEC. DIR., ACPC)” is hereby REVOKED. As such, the Council’s appointment of Executive Director Jocelyn Alma R. Badiola as ACPC’s permanent Executive Director shall remain in full force and effect.

This Order shall take effect immediately. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are likewise revoked.
