**SUBJECT: AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AGRIBUSINESS INVESTMENT
EVALUATION TRAINING COURSE ON NOVEMBER 28-30, 2022,
AT THE BOY SCOUT OF THE PHILIPPINES, LAGUNA**

In the interest of service, the Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Service - Agribusiness Promotion Division (AMAS-APD) is hereby authorized to conduct the Agribusiness Investment Evaluation Training Course on November 28-30, 2022, at the Boy Scout of the Philippines, Laguna.

The training program will provide the target participants with the necessary knowledge to analyze potential agribusiness investments through financial parameters. Further, it will enhance the capability of the Regional Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Divisions to assist the Farmers and Fisherfolk Cooperatives and Associations (FCAs) in their area of responsibility.
