**SUBJECT: RECONSTITUTING THE TRANSITION MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (TMC) FOR THE HUMAN SETTLEMENTS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (HSDC)**

In the interest of the service and in view of the separation and movement of DA officials previously comprising the Transition Management Committee (TMC) for the Human Settlements Development Corporation (HSDC), the TMC for HSDC is hereby reconstituted.

The TMC shall facilitate the liquidation of the affairs of the HSDC, including the transfer of the Maharlika Livelihood Center (MLC) to the City Government of Baguio. To accomplish the above, the Committee shall perform the following functions:

1. Oversee the winding down activities and such other activities related to the liquidation of the affairs of HSDC;

2. Review the Plan of Liquidation (POL) of HSDC and endorse the same to the Secretary for submission to the Governance Commission for Government Owned and Controlled Corporations (GCG);
3. Coordinate with the GCG on matters related to the approval and implementation of the HSDC Plan of Liquidation;
4. Oversee the transfer of the Maharlika Livelihood Center to the City Government of Baguio; and
5. Perform such functions necessary to ensure the full transfer of all functions and programs of HSDC to the appropriate recipients.

For the validity of agreements, documents, cheques and other instruments pertinent to the liquidation of the affairs of the HSDC, the authorized signatories are the TMC Chairman or Vice-Chairman and any two of its members.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until superseded and/or revoked. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
