SUBJECT : RECONSTITUTION OF THE DA-WIDE PROJECT CLEARINGHOUSE EXECUTIVE AND TECHNICAL COMMITTEES (EXECOM AND TECHCOM) AND TECHNICAL SECRETARIAT OF THE DA-WIDE PROJECT CLEARINGHOUSE SYSTEM

In the interest of service and to continuously operationalize the DA-Wide Project Clearinghouse System, the DA-Wide Project Clearinghouse EXECOM, TECHCOM, and TECHSEC are hereby reconstituted as follows:

III. Project Clearinghouse Technical Secretariat (TECHSEC)

Vice-Head : Division Chief, Project Identification and Evaluation Division (PIED) - PDS

Members : Staff under the PIED and/or any staff as may be assigned by the Head of the TECHSEC

The aforementioned officers shall mean currently appointed/designated officials/staff who are actually dispensing functions of their respective positions in various capacities (as Officer-in-Charge or in an acting/appointed capacity).

All expenses to be incurred by the EXECOM, TECHCOM, and TECHSEC in the performance of their duties and responsibilities as provided for Sections 1.A.2, 1.B.2, and 1.C.2 of the **DA Administrative Order No.29, Series of 2012**, shall be charged against the OSEC and/or PDS funds, subject to the existing government accounting and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless revoked in writing. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
