SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CLAIM FINANCIAL GRANT OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION (NCR) – REGIONAL LEVEL AWARDEES OF THE YOUNG FARMERS CHALLENGE (YFC) PROGRAM

Relative to the implementation of the Department of Agriculture's Young Farmers Challenge (YFC) Program, specifically the Regional Level competition, the following enterprises were selected and declared by the NCR panel of judges as the NCR-Regional Level awardees.
