SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT THE PRDP I-REAP PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW AND WORKSHOPS, AND 22nd NATIONAL I-REAP COORDINATION MEETING

In the exigency of service and for the effective implementation of the project, the Philippine Rural Development Project – I-REAP Component of the National Project Coordination Office (PRDP NPCO I-REAP) is hereby authorized to conduct The PRDP I-REAP Project Implementation Review and Workshops, and 22nd National I-REAP Coordination Meeting in CARAGA region on December 12-15, 2022.

The main objective of the activity is to assess the Component's performance and come up with strategies moving forward until the Project ends in July 2024 to include mainstreaming and institutionalization activities. Specifically, it aims to: (1) To discuss physical and financial performance of the Component in the implementation of subprojects and activities funded under sub-component 3.1 and 3.2 under the Additional Financing 2; (2) Discuss project design and pipeline subprojects for PRDP Phase 2; (3) Discuss and harmonize activities for 2020 and 2021; (4) Craft strategies to mainstream PRDP I-REAP to Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Service (AMAS) and the regional Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Divisions (AMADs); (5) Discuss findings and recommendations during the World Bank Implementation Support Mission and come up with action plans to comply with the findings and recommendations; and (6) To discuss outstanding issues and concerns in the implementation and provision of technical assistance to enterprises and come up with recommendations on how to address these.
