**SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT BFAR OPEN WATER AND
ADVANCED OPEN WATER SCUBA DIVING TRAINING
COURSE CERTIFICATION IN A PRIVATE FACILITY**

In the interest of service, the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources is hereby authorized to conduct the Open Water and Advanced Open Scuba Diving Training Course and Certification on December 19-23, 2022, in a private facility within Batangas. This is due to the non-availability of the government facilities in the area.

This activity will be conducted with the following objectives

1. To capacitate, enhance and strengthen BFAR FRMD personnel in SCUBA diving skills and coral reef monitoring survey and
2. To augment the pool of BFAR licensed SCUBA divers that will engage in the Coastal Resource Management (CRM) activities, deployment of artificial reefs and reef rehabilitation

Traveling expenses and per diem of participants shall be chargeable against the funds of their respective offices.
