FUNCTIONS & ROLES

- d. Assist in the preparation of presentation holding slides;
- e. Provide assistance/inputs in the development of press releases and articles for the website and conference app;





- g. Ensure smooth media coverage reporting;
- h. Provide assistance/ inputs in the development of conference promotional videos (pre and post event), promotional kits for sponsors;
- i. Ensure conference photo and documentation;
- j. Send published event teasers; and
- k. Provide inputs/ assistance in the development of sponsorship packages and sponsorship management.

The various Committees shall schedule individual and/or joint meetings to discuss the progress and preparations for the event and update the high-level advisory committee on their work to ensure that tasks are accomplished in a timely manner.
