AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT SERIES OF WORKSHOPS FOR THE OPERATIONALIZATION OF THE NATIONAL EVALUATION

POLICY FRAMEWORK (NEPF)

In the interest of service and pursuant to its mandate, the Monitoring and Evaluation Division of the Planning and Monitoring Service (PMS-MED) is hereby authorized to conduct series of workshops for the operationalization of the National Evaluation Policy Framework (NEPF) of the Department.

The series of workshops aim (i) to enhance the capacities of DA Neutral Evaluation Units (NEU) to undertake their roles specified under the NEPF Guidelines issued by NEDA and DBM and (ii) guide the NEU members on the different evaluation processes: initiation, preparation, implementation, and utilization. Venue

Rationale

The Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 issued by the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) directed all agencies to operationalize the National Evaluation Policy Framework (NEPF). The NEDA, in partnership with United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), has also issued the Guidelines on Evaluation in the National Government and conducted mentoring/ coaching sessions to pilot agencies.

As one of the pilot agencies, the Department started setting up its evaluation by identifying Neutral Evaluation Units (NEUs) in the DA Central and Operating Units. The identified NEUs in the Department will be capacitated on the various evaluation processes based on the guidelines on evaluation issued by NEDA.

Objectives

Specifically, the series of workshops aim to:

- Discuss the evaluation guidelines of the DA to institutionalize the operation of NEPF and understand how does it work in the central and operating units; [5]
- Capacitate the evaluation actors, especially the Neutral Evaluation Unit members on how to perform the M&E processes in accordance with the NEPF; and
- Assist the Neutral Evaluation Unit members in formulating/ developing all the expected outputs in the evaluation process.

Expected Outputs

- 1. Improved knowledge on DA's guidelines on evaluation including setting up of necessary institutional arrangements in DA offices;
- 2. Capacitated Neutral Evaluation Unit members to fulfill the duties and responsibilities in the institutionalization of

evaluation in the Department; and

3. Developed evaluation agenda and evaluation plans, and other necessary documents to successfully conduct the evaluation studies in the Department.
