SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AND ATTEND THE TRAINING ON CLIMATE AND DISASTER RISK ASSESSMENT (CDRA)

In the exigency of service and for the effective implementation of the Strategic Plan of Action for Disaster Risk Reduction in Agriculture and Fisheries, the Field Programs Operational Planning Division (FPOPD) is hereby authorized to conduct the Training on Climate and Disaster Risk Assessment (CDRA) on **March 27-31, 2023** in Albay, Bicol Region.

The aims of the training are as follows: 1) to further understand the processes of assessing climate-related hazards, vulnerabilities and risks in agriculture and fisheries; 2) to create a comprehensive strategy for building resilience and adaptation to assessing the risks and impacts of disasters in agriculture and fisheries due to climate change and disasters; 3) to provide an adequate and updated knowledge and information on climate change and disasters; 4) to serve as a venue to introduce entry points for CDRA and integration of risk-informed interventions in the plans following the mainstream; and 5) to mainstream the processes of contingency planning to build the capacity to effectively respond to any type of emergencies affecting the agriculture and fisheries sector.

The FPOPD collaborated with the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) to provide technical expertise on Climate Disaster Risk Assessment to the DA offices who have disaster risk reduction functions.
