As procurement coordinators, they shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. They are responsible for the planning and coordination with their respective budget officer for the preparation of Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) for the proceeding year;
- b. Prepare the Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) of their respective offices in coordination and approval of the Head of the Unit/Office;
- c. Act as End-user's representatives in all procurement activities;
- d. Coordinate with the procurement actors (BAC, BAC Secretariat, TWG,) regarding procurement requests;
- e. Prepare Procurement Request Action Slip (PRAS)/Purchase Requests (PRs) for their respective units following the timeline as indicated in their PPMPs;
- f. Responsible for seeking the approval of their Purchase Request and the corresponding revisions of their previously approved PPMP;
- g. Act as canvassers for items (goods/services, etc.) requested by their respective offices;
- h. Closely monitor their request with the BAC, through BAC-Secretariat, until the request evolved into an award of contract; and
- i. Regularly check updates about the status of their request using the Procurement Monitoring System (PMS) of the Procurement Division.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
