Duties and Responsibilities:

- Gather and consolidate raw data on poultry and livestock statistics data (volume of production, farm gate price, and inventory of animals);
- Process, analyze, interpret the data and come up with supply and demand analysis in different scenarios for the above commodities;
- Come up with forecasts and trend analysis taking into consideration demand and supply analysis, prices and animal inventories;
- Submit data and analysis to the Office of the Undersecretary for Policy, Planning and Regulation for harmonization;
- Publish reports such as Livestock and Poultry Situation, Supply and Demand Outlook, and Price Trends;
- Conduct regular consultation meetings with stakeholders and industry players on the actual supply and demand;
- Submit regular Food Supply Outlook for information and decision-making to the Office of the Senior Undersecretary through the Assistant Secretary for Operations;
- Conduct regular meetings and special meetings, if the need arises; and
- Perform other relevant tasks.

Expenses for the meals and other incidental expenses during meetings and workshops shall be charged against the National Livestock Program funds while traveling expense and per diem of the group members shall be charged against their respective agencies' funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. Special Orders No. 133, Series of 2021 dated January 29, 2021 and other orders, memoranda and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked..
