SUBJECT: RECONSTITUTION OF THE INTER-AGENCY TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

- 3. Submit IATC Resolutions and Eligibility Certification for IBM Allocation of MIPs to the Office of the Secretary (OSEC) for approval;
- 4. Provides policy direction and assistance to the TWGs including review of the existing rules and regulations on IBM importation and utilization; and
- 5. Provides oversight on TWGs responsibilities and activities.

Functions:

- 1. TWG member/s from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) shall be mainly responsible for:
 - a) timely provision of IBM importation data such as volume of IBM arrival from licensed IBM importers and other IBM related information; and
 - b) participation in IATC and TWG meetings.
- 2. The TWG members from the NMIS shall:
 - a) review documentary requirements of MIP applicants endorsed by the IBM Secretariat;
 - b) conduct onsite evaluation of meat processing plant (MPP) to assess MIPs eligibility for IBM allocation. In the event of an emergency or public health concern, remote or online evaluation can be an option;
 - c) submit evaluation report with recommended IBM allocation and TWG Resolution on time to the TWG Chairperson;
 - d) conduct monitoring activities to determine IBM utilization rate of respective MIPs; and
 - e) attend in IATC and TWG meetings.

Functions:

- 1. Review the existing rules and regulations pertaining to buffalo meat importation and utilization and recommend amendments and/or improvements to the IATC; and
- 2. Attend in IATC and TWG meetings.

Functions of the Secretariat:

- 1. Receive and perform initial evaluation of submitted documentary requirements of IBM applicants and endorse documents to the TWG on IBM allocation evaluators;
- 2. Coordinate communication among involved stakeholders;
- 3. Responsible for sending out notice of the meeting and memorandum regarding IBM;
- 4. Responsible for taking and/or recording minutes of the meeting (IATC and TWG) and other meetings such as public consultations related to IBM importation and utilization;
- 5. Assist in facilitating meetings and/or events regarding IBM;
- 6. Collate and act as repository of related documents and reports regarding IBM.
- 7. Perform other tasks as required by the IATC and TWGs.

All expenses in the performance of the functions of the members of the IATC, TWGs and secretariat are chargeable against their respective agencies' funds, subject to existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders, memoranda and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
