The duties and responsibilities of the Task Force are the following:

- 1. Evaluate the current market dynamics and trends in local poultry production, imports, domestic demand, prices, and the overall market conditions;
- 2. Identify potential remedies pursuant to international obligations and relevant laws, rules and regulations to address challenges and promote a fair and competitive poultry market;
- 3. Foster collaboration and active involvement of stakeholders to ensure their perspectives are considered in decision-making processes; and
- 4. Perform other duties as may be necessary.

The Task Force shall submit a report to the Office of the Secretary outlining its policy recommendations and other proposed anticipatory measures and strategies.

All agencies and offices within the Department are hereby enjoined to cooperate and extend all necessary support to the Task Force in the performance of its duties and responsibilities.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall be considered revoked upon submission of the report.
