Duties and responsibilities of the NFP:

- 1. Regularly attend the meetings, whether virtual or physical, and workshops of the relevant regional and international working groups, committees and trade agreements as Philippine representative and articulate Philippine Position;
- 2. Act as Chairperson of meetings, workshops, and other activities when Philippine will serve as host; Collaborate with relevant DA agencies during the drafting of Philippine position paper, including the data required in coming up with such position; and
- 3. Inform relevant DA agencies on the results of the meetings of regional and international working groups, committees and agreements.

The support agencies shall provide, as necessary, the relevant information needed by FPA, in carrying out its duties and responsibilities, which include, but is not limited to:

- 1. BAFS approved PNS and Codex Alimentarius Commission (Codex) standards related to pesticide MRL; and
- 2. BPI importing country regulations related to pesticide MRL.

The above agencies shall report to the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Regulations (OASR) and the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Policy Research and Development on matters related to pesticide MRL standards, regulations, and trade policies.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
