The FMSWG shall have the following functions:

- To organize and conduct a regular "Science-Management Forum" to discuss, review and provide advise on concerns, issues and other matters relating to fisheries science and management;
- 2. To strengthen institutional collaboration and cooperation between BFAR and NFRDI by identifying emerging research issues and agenda;
- 3. To formulate sharing mechanism on data and research results between NFRDI BFAR on Capture, Aquaculture, Postharvest Fisheries, etc.;
- 4. To assist the Fisheries Management Areas (FMA) in the formulation, adoption and implementation of livelihood interventions, manapower development, and harvest strategies;
- 5. To serve as Resource Person/s to DA-BFAR and DA-NFRDI, FMA Bodies, and other related bodies as maybe required or necessary;
- 6. To perform other functions as determined by the BFAR National Director and NFRDI Executive Director.

The members of the FMSWG are entitled to travelling expense, per diems and incidental expenses that may be incurred in the performance of their functions as designated, chargeable against their respective agencies' funds, subject to availability of funds and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders and memoranda and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
