SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO SPECIAL ORDER NOS. 33 AND 904 SERIES OF 2021 REGARDING PRICE MONITORING TEAM OF AMAS

The concerned staff are tasked to conduct regular price monitoring from Monday to Friday and during holidays and weekends, as the need arises. They should be at their areas of assignment as early as 5:00 am.

With the foregoing, the concerned staff are hereby exempted from the regular official time of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm specifically as follows:

- Exemption of the Price Monitors from using the biometric bundy clock in the morning since they are required to be in their respective market assignment as early as 5:00 am every Monday to Saturday;
- Flexi time –in and time out for the Data Analysts, since they are required to be in the office as early as 5:30 am to do quick data analysis, their 8-hour workday ends at 2:30 pm at the earliest; and
- Compensatory Time Offsetting for work on Holidays and weekends.

The Personnel Division is tasked to use other legally accepted means of monitoring the time and attendance of the aforementioned personnel while performing their functions (e.g. daily time records, log books, certificate of appearance, certification, etc.) and/or will recognize the log out at the biometric system in the afternoon after the completion of at least 8-hour work day.


All expenses to be incurred relative to the conduct of the price monitoring, market mapping and profiling, and other activities related to the implementation of Price Act shall not exceed P350.00 per day per staff, chargeable against AMAS funds, subject to fund availability and the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

In the event that the price and supply monitoring staff uses government vehicle, he/she shall be allowed to collect P150.00 per day.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing.

All other issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
