CREATION OF THE FY 2023 YOUNG FARMERS CHALLENGE PROGRAM PANELS OF JUDGES AND PROGRAM MANAGEMENT TEAMS

In the exigency of service and pursuant to the implementation of the Young Farmers Challenge Program FY 2023 under Memorandum Circular No. 15 Series of 2023 "Implementing Guidelines for the Young Farmers Challenge (YFC) Program – Component 1: YFC Start Up, Subcomponent A: Open Category" and Memorandum Circular No. 16 Series of 2023 "Implementing Guidelines for the Young Farmers Challenge (YFC) Program – Component 2: YFC Upscale, Subcomponent A: Enterprise Scaling Up, the National Panel of Judges, National and Regional Program Management Team, and the NCR Panel of Judges are hereby created as follows:

- 2. Responsible for judging the Top 16 National Level Finalists (*1 finalist per region*) according to the set standard criteria and scoring system; and
- 3. Declare the Top 5 (five) YFC Upscale National Level awardees.

FUNCTIONS OF THE NPMT

The National PMT shall provide administrative and technical support in the overall implementation of the Young Farmers Challenge Program FY 2023. Specifically, the National PMT shall:

- 1. Oversee the nationwide implementation of the YFC program and its program components i.e. Start-Up, Upscale, Intercollegiate, Business Development Assistance, and YFC Camp;
- 2. Prepare the plans, activities, and timeline of the program;
- 3. Prepare the score sheets and other pertinent documents to be endorsed to the National Panel of Judges;
- 4. Receive the documents submitted by the NCR applicants and check the completeness of attachments, conduct background checks among NCR applicants, and endorse the eligible NCR applicants to the NCR Panel of Judges;
- 5. Assist in the evaluation of each proposed Business Model Canvas (BMC)
- 6. Conduct regular monitoring and assessment for the awardees' enterprise implementation;
- 7. Prepare administrative and accomplishment reports and maintain files and records of the program; and
- 8. Perform other related tasks as may be assigned by the National Focal Person of the NPMT.

B. COMPOSITION OF THE REGIONAL PROGRAM MANAGEMENT TEAM (RPMT)

The implementation of the YFC program shall be lodged at the Agribusiness and Marketing Service (AMAS) in the Central Office and the Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Divisions (AMADs) in the DA Regional Field Office.

FUNCTIONS OF THE RPMT

- 1. Oversee and facilitate smooth implementation of the YFC program and its program components in their respective regions i.e. Start-Up, Upscale, Intercollegiate, Business Development Assistance, and YFC Camp;
- 2. Spearhead the information and dissemination campaign of the YFC program;
- 3. Facilitate Business Model Canvas (BMC) Orientation/ BMC Preparation Write shops;
- 4. Receive and screen the applications from the YFC regional applicants;
- 5. Endorse eligible applicants to the Provincial Panel of Judges;
- 6. Process the release of funds to declared awardees;

- 7. Facilitate the provision of business development service assistance to the youth awardees;
- 8. Conduct regular review, monitoring and evaluation of the declared awardees' enterprise implementation; and
- 9. Perform other related tasks as may be assigned by the Regional Executive Directors (REDs).

IV. CREATION OF THE PROVINCIAL AND REGIONAL PANEL OF JUDGES

The DA Regional Executive Directors (REDs) shall designate through a Special Order their respective Provincial and Regional Panel of Judges for Start-Up and Upscale and Regional Panel of Judges for Intercollegiate Competition to be composed of not more than three (3) members with representations of one (1) from the DA, one representative from the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), and one (1) private sector practitioner (from the agribusiness industry) endorsed by the Regional Agricultural and Fishery Council (RAFC).

As such, they shall perform all necessary functions, duties, and responsibilities inherent to their designation pertinent to the Memorandum Circular No. 15 Series of 2023 "Implementing Guidelines for the Young Farmers Challenge (YFC) Program – Component 1: YFC Start Up, Subcomponent A: Open Category" and Memorandum Circular No. 16 Series of 2023 "Implementing Guidelines for the Young Farmers Challenge (YFC) Program – Component 2: YFC Upscale, Subcomponent A: Enterprise Scaling Up.

All expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, functions, and responsibilities such as traveling expenses, per diem, communication allowance, and honoraria for resource persons and judges shall be charged against the Young Farmers Challenge Fund under FY 2023 General Appropriations Act (RA 11936) subject to the existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately and shall be considered revoked upon completion of this Program. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
