Pursuant to <sup>1</sup>Executive Order No. 70, Series of 2018, which institutionalizes the whole of nation approach in attaining inclusive and sustainable peace, and the designation of Assistant Secretary James A. Layug as the Department's <sup>2</sup>permanent alternate representative for NTF-ELCAC and <sup>3</sup>chairman of NTF-ELCAC Poverty Reduction, Livelihood and Employment Cluster (PRLEC), the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Inspectorate and Enforcement (DAIE) is hereby authorized to conduct the NTF-ELCAC PRLEC Strategic Planning Workshop on the following dates and location:
