SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AND ATTEND ACTIVITIES IN OBSERVANCE OF THE 2023 NATIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE CONSCIOUSNESS (NCCC) WEEK

Pursuant to Proclamation No. 1667, Series of 2008 declaring November 19-25, 2008 and every year thereafter as “Global Warming and Climate Change Consciousness Week”, the DA Adaptation and Mitigation Initiative in Agriculture (AMIA) and DA Balik Probinsya, Bagong Pag-asa (BP2) Program are hereby authorized to conduct a week-long activity in observance of the Climate Change Consciousness Week such as Exhibit, Technical Forum and the FY 2023 AMIA and BP2 Performance Review on November 20-23, 2023 in the National Capital Region (NCR).

The activity aims to:
