**SUBJECT : CREATION OF THE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE FOR THE DA REGULATORY CLEARINGHOUSE SYSTEM**

In the exigency of the service, and to operationalize and implement the relevant provisions of Administrative Circular No. 1, series of 2024, with the subject "*Guidelines on the Conduct of Regulatory Impact Assessment (RIA) for the Proposed Regulations in the Department Of Agriculture*, the Oversight Committee of the Regulatory Clearinghouse System is hereby created to be composed of the following:

The Oversight Committee shall have the following functions:

1. Review and provide comments on proposed regulations for issuance by the regulatory agencies of the Department based on consistency with existing laws, policies, and regulations;
2. Endorse to the Anti-Red Tape Authority (ARTA) all proposed regulations for Preliminary Impact Assessment (PIA) or Regulatory Impact Assessment (RIA) as may be necessary;
3. Issue clearance to the proponent agencies to proceed to legal review by the Legal Service and secure the relevant legal clearances prior to the issuance of the regulation by the Secretary or Head of relevant Regulatory Agency; and,





4. Conduct other activities relevant to the implementation of Administrative Circular No. 1, series of 2024.

All expenses to be incurred by the Oversight Committee in the performance of their duties and function shall be charged against DA OSEC funds, subject to the existing government accounting and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders, memoranda, and other issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed revoked.
