SUBJECT: RECONSTITUTION OF THE NCI-SRD COMPONENT WORKING GROUP (CWG) MEMBERS AND THEIR PERMANENT ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES

In the interest of the service and with reference to the DA-DAR-DENR-DILG Joint Administrative Order (JAO) No. 01 series of 2020 (Revised JAO No. 01 Series of 2015: Strengthening the Implementation Framework of the DA-DAR-DENR-DILG NCI-SRD), the members and permanent alternate representatives of the four NCI-SRD Component Working Groups (CWGs) namely, the Policy and Advocacy (PA) CWG, Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries Enterprise Cluster and Business Development (AFFECBD) CWG, Capacity Development (CD) CWG, and Knowledge Management (KM) CWG are hereby designated as follows:

- Identify issues that require legislation and coordinate with the appropriate offices, agencies, and stakeholders involved in advocating for the respective legislation.

The KM CWG shall have the following functions:


- Develop and manage an information system for the NCI-SRD; and
- Develop, implement, monitor and evaluate the NCI-SRD Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Results-Based Monitoring and Evaluation (RBME) system, and Information, Education, Communication and Motivational (IECM) materials.

Designated members and their permanent alternate representative/s shall include all activities in relation to the fulfillment of the above-mentioned functions in the Individual Performance Commitment and Review (IPCR), Division Performance Commitment and Review (DPCR), and Office Performance Commitment and Review (OPCR) of their respective offices consistent with the implementation of the NCI-SRD Joint Resolution No. 18, series of 2018, "Inclusion of the NCI-SRD Activities in the IPCR, DPCR, and OPCR of the NCI-SRD National and Regional Members."

Furthermore, expenses to be incurred for the conduct of the activities related to the performance of the functions and assigned tasks shall be chargeable against the funds of their respective offices, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
