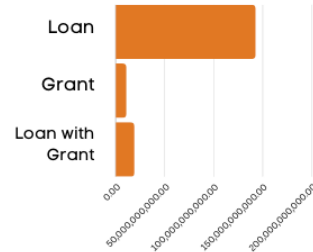

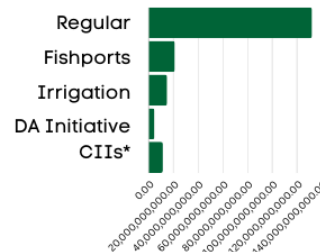

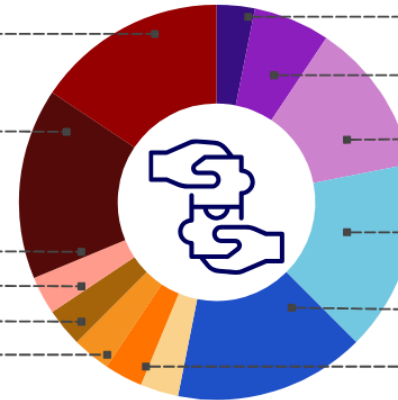

DA Special Projects under the General Appropriations Act (GAA) are funded through and with attributions from the Government of the Philippines (GoP) while the Non-GAA are purely grant from development partners.

DA Special Projects also extend necessary support to the local farmers and fisherfolk in terms of production support, infrastructure investment, livelihood assistance and enterprise development, upgrading/modernizing laboratories, and other facilities, as well as upgrading the capacity of the client and implementers alike, among others.

In terms of funding, the World Bank is still on top for having the highest funding support at Php 109.58 billion (63.28%) through the projects: Fourth Disaster Risk Management (DRM) Development Policy Loan with Catastrophe-Deferred Drawdown Option (CAT-DDO4); Mindanao Inclusive Agriculture Development (MIADP); Philippine Fisheries and Coastal Resiliency (FishCore); and Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP) Additional Financing 2 and PRDP Scale Up.
