The aims of the conduct of the activity are:

- 1. Enhance the entrepreneurial skills of the YFC Awardees;
- 2. Assist in the promotion of the YFC products;
- 3. Expand the market for the products of the YFC Awardees;
- 4. Link the YFC Awardees to government and private institutions for possible collaboration;
- 5. Feature the YFC program, its awardees, and their products to encourage other youths to engage in agriculture; and
- 6. Monitor and profile the enterprise implementation of the awardees, and determine the appropriate assistance needed to level up their enterprises.

All expenses to be incurred in the conduct of the YFC-BDS activities, such as food, fuel/gasoline, toll fee, parking fee, travelling, and other supplies and materials shall be charged against the Young Farmers Challenge Fund FY 2024 General Appropriations Act (RA 11975), subject to the availability of funds and the existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall be considered revoked upon completion of the activities. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
