SUBJECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AND PARTICIPATE IN A SERIES OF CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES ON RESULTS-BASED MONITORING AND EVALUATION FOR SELECTED PLANNING, MONITORING AND EVALUATION OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT

In the interest of service and pursuant to its mandate, the Monitoring and Evaluation Division of the Planning and Monitoring Service (PMS) is hereby authorized to spearhead a series of capacity development activities on Results-Based Monitoring and Evaluation (RBME) for selected Planning, Monitoring and Evaluation Officers of the Department of Agriculture. The list of activities and respective schedules, venues and participants is shown in attachment 1.

The aims of the activities are: (1) Enhance the competencies of selected DA Planning Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Officers in RBME: (2) Review/finalize program/project designs which include, among others – Theory of Change (TOC) and Logical Frameworks with accompanying Results indicators; and (3) Develop program/project M&E plans.

Travelling expenses and per diem of participants shall be charged against their respective offices while expenses in the conduct of the activity such as food, accommodation and other incidental expenses including professional fees and fares of the Resource Persons shall be chargeable against PMS funds, subject to the availability of funds and the existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulation.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall be considered revoked upon the completion of the activity. All orders, memoranda, and issuance inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
