SUBJECT: AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AND ATTEND IN THE FY 2024 1ST QUARTER ASSESSMENT AND PLANNING WORKSHOP FOR THE 2024 WET SEASON CROPPING OF THE NATIONAL CORN PROGRAM

In the interest of service, the National Corn Program (NCP) is hereby authorized to conduct the FY 2024 1st Quarter Assessment and Planning Workshop for the 2024 Wet Season Cropping on May 6 - 10, 2024 in Dipolog City, Region IX.

The activity aims to:

- Evaluate the FY 2024 1st Quarter physical accomplishment of the implementing /operating units of the NCP per Budget Execution Document (BED)2;
- Assess the FY 2024 1st Quarter financial performance of the implementing/operating units of NCP per BED 1 (obligation) and BED 3 (disbursement);
- Discuss and provide recommendations on the issues, concerns and challenges in the implementation of the NCP; and
- Assess the status of FY 2024 Wet Season Cropping interventions and formulate catch up plans.
