The NPCO of MIADP shall:

1. Oversee project performance and provide guidance in the management and operations of MIADP activities to improve project operational and institutional processes;
2. Facilitate coordination with the oversight agencies, World Bank and other relevant national government agencies and stakeholders pertaining to MIADP transactions;
3. Conduct quarterly meetings with the MIADP PSO and RPCOs or whenever necessary; and
4. Perform such other functions as may be deemed necessary for efficient execution of Project activities.

They are entitled to traveling expenses, per diem, incidental expenses, and honoraria not exceeding 25% of their annual basic salary per DBM Budget Circular No. 2007-2, chargeable against MIADP funds, subject to availability of funds and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

All officials and employees of the Department including its Bureaus, Attached Agencies and Corporations, Service Units, and Regional Field Offices are hereby directed to give their full support and cooperation to the MIADP NPCO in the performance of their functions.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
